The best time to send the welcome letter is after the lease has been signed by both parties but before the key handover and move-in days. The reason for this is because one part of this welcome letter is to inform your new tenant of move-in details, when and how to collect the keys, and so on. 1 to 2 weeks before the move-in date is normally a good time to send the letter.
