Plant a maple when the air and soil are cool to promote root growth. In many climates, late spring and early fall are the best times to plant maple trees. Aim for a time when the air temperature is comfortably cool—not freezing cold nor uncomfortably hot. Likewise, the soil should be cool but not frozen (or nearly frozen).

Plant a maple tree in early spring, just as other plants are starting to put on buds. Make sure that the danger of a hard frost has passed. Never transfer a tree directly from a heated environment to cold soil to avoid shocking the roots.

Hold the maple tree seedling straight while you fill the hole with soil. Tamp the soil down around the ball with the end of a 4x4 until the soil level is about three-fourths the depth of the hole. Be careful not to damage roots in this step! Cut away the exposed burlap in the top one-fourth of the hole.

Most maples do well in partial shade, but look up the exact species if possible for more info on planting. To increase the odds of survival, start the seedlings in an indoor seed tray

instead. Fill the tray with 7.6–10 cm (3–4 inches) of well-draining potting soil, or an even mix of peat moss, rotted compost, vermiculite, and coarse sand.

Plant your maple saplings between now and mid-October. Don't wait for spring. Maples grow best in a well drained loamy to sandy loam soil. At the selected planting site, remove any surface litter and dig a hole at least twice as wide and 1 1/2 times the depth of the pot.

You want the trees to properly harden off before winter. Allow enough space for your Japanese maple tree: Be sure to consider the space available, both height and width of the planting location when choosing a tree. Most standard palmatum type varieties grow 15-20 feet tall and 6-8 feet wide.
