NFPA 99 treats emergency generators as part of an essential electrical system (EES), which is defined as, "A system comprised of alternate sources of power and all connected distribution systems and ancillary equipment, designed to ensure continuity of electrical power to designated areas and functions of a health care facility during disruption of normal power sources, and also to minimize disruption within the internal wiring system." [see NFPA 99 (99), Chapter 2, Definitions].
