The three dimensions of oppression that are discussed by Patricia Hill Collins are individual, institutional and symbolic. The individual is being capable of being oppressed and of oppressing others. According to Patricia Hill Collins the matrix of domination is "the form assumed by intersecting oppressions in one social location... and can be seen as a historically specific organization of power in which social groups are embedded and which they aim to influence"7.
