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Executive Functioning IEP Goals.

Executive function is an umbrella term for cognitive processes such as planning, working memory, attention, problem solving, verbal reasoning, inhibition, mental flexibility, multi-tasking, initiation, and monitoring of actions.

Executive functioning describes a set of mental processes that helps people to connect past experience with present action.

Executive Functioning | Measurable IEP Goals ...

Working memory (WM) affects language

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development. When we hear sentences, the brain has to hold on to the information, process it, and properly store it. This processing happens at the sound level and at the word level. At the sound level, our brain decodes sounds and then uses that “decoded message” to decide what word it just heard.

Working memory is a temporary storage system and is vital for many day-to-day tasks (e.g. following instructions, responding in conversations, listening and reading comprehension, organisation).

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IEP for low processing speed/working memory
